WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

Nationality

You and your parent(s) must NOT be of Korean nationality

Academic requirements

A bachelor's degree or its equivalent from an accredited domestic / international institution

Language proficiency - English

TOEFL 71 (i) 197 (C) 530 (P); IELTS 5.5; TEPS 600 or higher strongly recommended

* Students from countries where English is a native or official language, as well as those who have obtained a bachelor's degree from a university in an English-speaking country, are exempt from submitting official English test scores at the time of admission. However, submission of an official English test score is mandatory prior to graduation.

Documents and materials

- Kyung Hee University Graduate School of Business Application Form**
- Self-Introduction Letter**
- Statement of Purpose** * Must include individual study plans
- Official Graduation Certificates** (or pre-graduation certificate) from undergraduate institution
* Must be verified by Apostille or by Consular Authentication at the Korean Consulate
• For applicants from China: Submit graduation or degree certificates from the China Higher Education Student Information System
- Official Transcripts** from each college/university attended as a registered student, reported using the school's grading scale, and verified by Apostille or Consular Authentication at the Korean Consulate
- Copy of Bank Certificate of Deposit Balance**
* Attach a bank certificate showing a minimum deposit of \$20,000, either under your name or your parent's name
• If the certificate is under the name of an immediate family member, proof of financial capability must also be submitted.
• The bank balance certificate must be issued within one month from the application start date and remain valid until the actual enrollment date.
• Admitted applicants must submit the original bank balance certificate, which is required for the issuance of the Certificate of Admission.
- Copy of Parents' Passports**
- State or Government-Issued Certificate of Family Registry** verifying you and your family relationship
* Must be verified by Apostille or Consular Authentication at the Korean Consulate
- Academic Certificate Verification Signed Consent Form**
- Official English Language Test Transcripts**

Additional Notes

- **Consular Authentication:** The document must bear the official seal of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the applicant's home country and the confirmation seal of the Korean consulate in that country.
- **Apostille:** Must be issued in the country where the university is located
- **Translation Requirements:** Certificates issued in languages other than Korean or English must be submitted with a Korean or English translation, verified either by Apostille or Consular Authentication.
- **Submission Requirements:** All documents must be submitted as originals, and only those issued within six months from the application start date will be accepted * Bank balance certificates and official language test score reports are exempt from this timeframe.

Applicants' Guidelines

1. All submitted documents and application fees are non-refundable.
2. All required documents must be submitted within the designated deadline; failure to do so will result in disqualification.
3. The university is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from the loss of documents if they are not submitted via registered mail or in person.
4. If admission is obtained through improper means or if any false information is found in the application materials, the university reserves the right to revoke admission and may pursue civil or criminal liability.

KEYSTONE MBA DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

To successfully complete the Keystone MBA program and earn a legitimate degree, students must fulfill the following requirements:

1. Credit Requirements

- Total Credits for MBA Degree: Minimum of 36 credits
- Credits per Course: 2 credits

2. Core Curriculum

- Integrative Core: A minimum of 12 credits
- Elective Seminars : A minimum of 24 credits, including 6 credits for the thesis

3. Graduation Exams

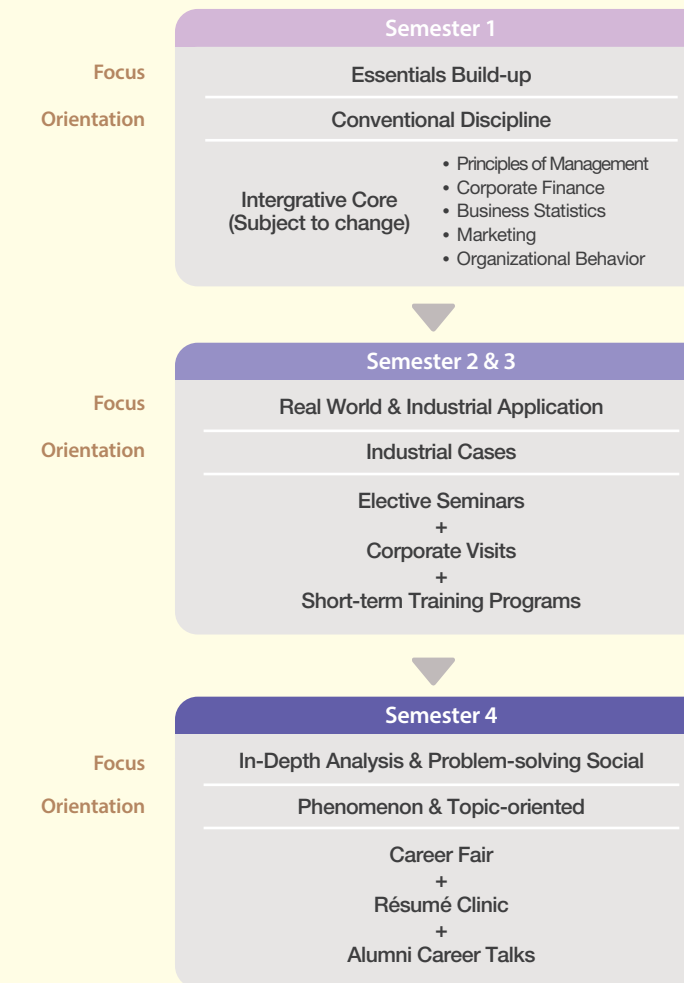
- Students must pass two exams of their choice.

4. Thesis Requirements

Students must meet one of the following criteria,

- Thesis Submission: Pass the thesis evaluation during the final semester and submit an approved master's thesis
- Thesis-Substitute Courses: Complete three thesis-substitute courses (totaling 6 credits) in place of the thesis. Each course must be completed with a minimum grade of B (80 points) or higher.
